Dear Deputy Ó Broin

I refer to the above Parliamentary Question which has been referred by the Minister for Health to the Health Service Executive for direct response. I requested that the Interim CEO of CRC, the lead agency for the Children's Disability Network Team examine the matter and the following outlines the position.

I can confirm that the CDNT in Clondalkin will be moving to a new purpose-built site on Boot Road in Clondalkin. Primary Care Services will also be located in this same building. The reason for this move to Boot Road is to provide much needed and improved facilities for the children and their families who are in receipt of services from the CDNT, and also for the staff team. The CDNT have been based in portacabins on the grounds of Scoil Mochua since reconfiguration in September 2021 and these are completely inadequate.

I would also like to reassure parents of children attending Scoil Mochua that supports to the school will continue following this move.
