PQ 9471/23* To ask the Minister for Health the position regarding the development of a building to serve as a permanent vaccination centre (details supplied: St. John's Hospital, Enniscorthy, Co. Wexford) and if he will make a statement on the matter. -James Browne

Dear Minister Browne,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

At the request of the local HSE service, Capital & Estates progressed a project for the provision of a long term vaccination centre in Enniscorthy.

Development of a permanent vaccination centre at St John's Hospital, Enniscorthy has recently been completed, and the centre is now operational.

The vaccination centre provides 6 bays and is capable of operating 7 days per week offering potential vaccination delivery of 2,000 per week. The vaccination centre is presently operating 1-2 days meeting current demand for covid vaccinations.

Other services may make use of the facility as appropriate, if required.
