To ask the Minister for Health the number of approved HSE homecare hours provided per month in County Wexford; the number of HSE homecare hours at present being delivered in County Wexford; the number of clients per months in receipt of homecare hours in County Wexford; the numbers of approved HSE homecare support hours waiting allocation in County Wexford; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which was submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I have reviewed the matter and the following is the current position based on most recent data available.

The Home Support Office confirm that in County Wexford, during the month of December 2022 there were 62 new persons approved for HSE Homecare Support Hours and placed on the waiting list. There were a further 51 clients, currently in receipt of a Home Support service



approved for additional homecare support hours also placed on the waiting list for these additional hours.

The Home Support Service continues to operate within the constraints of available staffing resources. South East Community Healthcare is acutely aware that there are capacity issues across both direct and indirect provision of Home Support. We continue to advertise on an on-going basis for and to recruit as many suitable candidates as possible. Additional Home Support staffing once in place can be allocated to clients on the waiting list.
