The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply to you directly in the context of the above question, which you submitted to the Minister for response.

As with other medical conditions, there is no specific category for persons who are blind or vision impaired. Equipment is provided on the basis of an assessed clinical need, and is available to all eligible clients irrespective of the underlying medical condition that has given arise to the need that the particular piece of equipment is designed to address.
