Dear Deputy Murphy,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you with information in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The HSE provides funding through a Grant Aid Agreement to the Irish Motor Neurone Disease Association (IMNDA) to the value of €270,852 per annum. The IMNDA employs four nurses that work regionally and who conduct assessments of each patient. The nursing team provides a national service, visiting clients in their own home, providing phone support and working closely with community multidisciplinary teams.
