**To ask the Minister for Health if he will provide a report on the prescribing practices for risperidone; the average length of time a child is on this medication, in tabular form; and if he will make a statement on the matter. -Mark Ward**

Dear Deputy Ward,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question (Reference 4567/23), which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

Risperidone is available on the Reimbursement List in various strengths and formulations. Products are reimbursed under Community Drug Schemes. The information provided is based on claim data which has been received by the Primary Care Reimbursement Service (PCRS) from Community Pharmacy Contractors and includes items reimbursed by PCRS only.

This data does not capture items dispensed outside of Community Drug Schemes where the prescription has been paid for privately by the patient/patient representative or claims which are under the DPS monthly threshold amount.

PCRS does not capture data in relation to prescribing practices such as individual dosing regimens, diagnosis or indication for treatment.
