Dear Deputy Naughten,

I refer to the recent PQ made regarding the Long COVID Clinic in the Mater Misericordiae University Hospital, which has been referred to the Ireland East Hospital Group for direct response.

I have had this matter examined and am advised that there has been no feedback received on the business case submitted to HSE dated July 2022 or confirmation of funding for the Long COVID clinic in the Mater Misericordiae University Hospital.

Unfortunately, in the absence of funding or feedback from the business case, the Long COVID clinic in the Mater Hospital closed at the end of 2022. Patients are being referred on to funded Long COVID clinics in other sites.
