The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The Dundrum site is in the process of being transferred from the HSE to the Office of Public Works (OPW). The Land Development Agency (LDA) commenced planning permission process for housing for the site in recent years and this process is ongoing. The HSE will not receive any funding from the transfer of the site from HSE to OPW as this is a public owned site.
