Dear Deputy Wynne,

In 2022 there were 11 posts recruited in Child & Adolescent Mental Health Services in the Mid-West.

- 1 x Social Worker Team Leader
- 1 x Clinical Nurse Specialist
- 1 x Senior Psychologist
- Ix Senior Occupational Therapist
- 2 x Staff Grade Psychologist
- 4 x Grade IV Administration
- 1 x Senior Registrar

In 2023 so far there have been 4 Posts Recruited

- 1 x Social Work Team Leader
- 1 x Grade IV Administration
- 1 x Speech & Language Therapist
- 1 x Consultant Psychiatrist

I wish to advise that the current vacancies in CAMHS Mid-West are as listed below:

- 2 WTE staff grade psychologist
- 4 WTE Social Worker
- 2 WTE Speech & Language Therapists

In 2023 there were 2 campaigns ran for Child & Adolescent Mental Health Staff (Consultant Psychiatrist in January 2023 and a Staff Nurse in June 2023).

As above levels of recruitment demonstrate, Human Resources have prioritised the recruitment of staff for Child & Adolescent Mental Health Services. Filling vacancies is a key priority for us, and I confirm that we are progressing the backfill of the above vacant posts in a timely manner.
