"To ask the Minister for Health for an update on plans for a primary care centre in Blarney, County Cork; and if he will make a statement on the matter."

Dear Deputy O'Sullivan,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

HSE were engaged with a Developer for this proposed Primary Care Centre and Cork County Council had granted planning permission for the proposed centre. The planning decision was appealed to An Bord Pleanála, who upheld the planning decision, however this decision was then appealed to the High Court. An Bord Pleanála have decided not to issue a defence at the High Court with the result that the Planning Permission will be void. HSE are conducting a review of the options available for this proposed PCC and this review is due to be completed in the coming weeks. On completion of this review, HSE will issue further communication to the proposed PCC Developer to confirm HSE's position regarding the advancement of this development.
