Dear Deputy Donnelly,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The table below outlines the number of whole-time equivalent (WTE) Psychologists and Social Workers approved for Blakestown and Blanchardstown Children's Disability Network Teams (CDNT's) in 2021, 2022 and to date in 2023.

In addition, both the Blanchardstown and Blakestown CDNT's have approval for a temporary wholetime Psychology Assistants (1 WTE each). The post in Blakestown CDNT has been filled, while the Blanchardstown CDNT post is currently vacant and recruitment is ongoing. Senior Medical Social Worker posts are not included in the CDNT model and therefore, neither Blakestown and Blanchardstown CDNTs have one.

HSE Community Healthcare Organisation Dublin North City and County (CHO DNCC) Disability Services with the Central Remedial Clinic, St Michael's House and Avista are running a targeted international recruitment campaign for the staff grades referenced above and interviews are ongoing. Concurrently CHO DNCC have undertaken to increase administrative support to all the CDNTs, to enable existing clinical staff to devote more of their time directly to children and families.

I trust this information clarifies this matter for you.
