To ask the Minister for Health the number of patients who were presented to St. Loman's, Mullingar, in 2021 and 2022; the number of people who repeated presentations; and the number of people who subsequently ended their own lives. -Robert Troy

Dear Deputy Troy

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and I outline the position as follows.

I would like to apologise for the delay in responding to this question. This was due to the significant data analysis required. The following is the response for the CHO8 Mental Health Services

Mental Health Services report all sudden, unexplained deaths of patients known to the service. Of those reported across 2021/2022, fewer than 5 cases were in people who were assessed in St Loman's in the weeks prior to their death. Exact numbers cannot be provided due to the risk of identifying individual cases.
