To ask the Minister for Children; Equality; Disability; Integration and Youth the respite services available for people with an intellectual disability in Gorey, County Wexford, following the closure of the respite house in St. Aidan's, Gorey, County Wexford; the measures being taken to ensure that an adequate replacement is sourced; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Kehoe,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which was submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I have reviewed the matter and the following is the current position.

Wexford Disability Services were advised on 28th April 2023 of the temporary closure of respite services in Mulcahy House. The Disability Team will work with St. Aidans to identify those children and adults for whom additional supports may be required and they will be prioritised for alternative supports subject to availability.

Wexford Disability Services will link with St. Aidans to try to resolve the current issue and plan for respite maximum capacity when the service re-opens in twelve weeks.
