"To ask the Minister for Health the progress made to date in the establishment of the integrated care of chronic disease management hub based in north Cork; the location of the hub; the number of staff working in the hub and their respective roles, in tabular form; the number of patients treated at the hub to date in 2023; and if he will make a statement on the matter."

Dear Deputy Stanton,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

HSE Estates are actively progressing interim accommodation arrangements in Mallow Primary Care Centre and associated reconfiguration to facilitate the North Cork Chronic Disease Management Hub (CDM). It is anticipated the hub will be operational in the last quarter of 2023. Long-term accommodation for the North Cork CDM Hub is also being progressed.

For Recruitment Summary inclusive of the number of staff recruited and their respective roles: Refer to Appendix A

Until Short Term Accommodation arrangements have been finalised, CDM Staff are currently working between the Community Healthcare Networks (CHNs) in North Cork and the CDM North City Hub.
