Dear Deputy Kelly,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The Primary Care Centre (PCC) in Roscrea is being delivered through the HSE's Primary Care Centre Operational Lease mechanism.

It is intended that the following services will be delivered from Roscrea Primary Care Centre - Public Health Nursing / Community Nursing, Occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy, Speech & Language Therapy, Podiatry, Dental, Administrative services and HSE schemes. In addition, there will be a further visiting clinics to include Dietetics, Social Work, Ophthalmology and CAMHS.

Construction of the centre is due to be completed in Q3 2023, and this will be followed by a process of equipping and commissioning of the new facility.

It is anticipated Roscrea Road Primary Care Centre will be operational in Q1 2024.
