To ask the Minister for Health the number of children awaiting a physiotherapy appointment in CHO1; the breakdown of the time they have been on the waiting list; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Naughten

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The below table provides a breakdown of the number of children awaiting physiotherapy appointments in Community Healthcare Cavan Donegal Leitrim Monaghan and Sligo (CH CDLMS).

The number of children awaiting a physiotherapy appointment in CH CDLMS and a breakdown of the time they have been on the waiting list

As you may be aware, approval to address the waiting list for Paediatric Services in Cavan Monaghan through a targeted Waiting List Initiative for Occupational Therapy and Physiotherapy Services has commenced. This involves delivering both assessment and intervention to those children waiting longest, which included children referred in 2015, for Occupational Therapy and Physiotherapy. The implementation of the initiative has commenced and significant progress has been made to date, with the longest wait for a child now those children referred in July 2019, compared to 2015 at the commencement of the initiative. Of those children waiting >52 weeks in Cavan Monaghan, 59 are waiting 52 - 104 weeks with the remaining 86 children waiting >104 weeks. This represents significant and steady progress.
