The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you with information in the context of the above Parliamentary Question. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

Within Community Healthcare Organisation Dublin North City and County (CHO DNCC), the number of children waiting for their Primary Care Physiotherapy appointment is 987 children, as below:

The longest waiting time is 176 weeks for 0-4 age group and 223 weeks for 5-18 year age group.

There are a number of initiatives to reduce the waiting lists which include regular case discussions at the Paediatric Physiotherapy Primary Care Meetings and repriortising cases when required.
