**To ask the Minister for Health the number of addiction rehabilitation, detox and stabilisation beds opened in CHO5 in the years of 2022 and to date in 2023, in tabular form; and if he will make a statement on the matter.**

Dear Deputy Murnane O'Connor,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which was submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

*I have examined the matter and the following response outlines the current position.*

The following table lists the number of Detox and Rehabilitation beds available as at May 2023 in residential addiction services provided directly by agencies that are in receipt of funding from the HSE, in South East Community Healthcare (formerly CHO 5).

Stabilisation beds for SECH residents can be accessed through St Michael's Ward, Beaumont Hospital, Dublin.
