To ask the Minister for Health to list the hospitals with the National Acute Oncology Nursing Service to assist patients undergoing active cancer treatment in avoiding attending the emergency department; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Hourigan,

- Currently the Acute Oncology Nursing service is operational Monday to Friday from 8am 4pm
 in all of the 26 SACT hospital listed below. One specialist nurse was appointed to support each
 SACT service in 2021.
- There is no dedicated Nurse Specialist in the acute oncology service after these hours, there is no
 dedicated nurse specialist weekend cover and no annual leave cover when the nurse specialist is
 off.
- Our aim is to build resilience in this service so that it will be available to all patients nationally 24/7. This will require additional nursing and administrative resources which we are seeking approval for through the National Service Planning process.
