PQ Question: To ask the Minister for Health the number of patients waiting on trolleys at University Hospital Kerry each day in May 2023, in tabular form; if an explanation can be provided for the figures on each of these days; if these figures are the worst ever monthly total at UHK; if he has had direct contact with management concerning this; if so, if he will provide details of any such communications; and if he will make a statement on the matter. -Brendan Griffin

The above data confirms ED presentations for the May 2023 were higher than those of May 2022, which accounts for the higher number of patients waiting on trolleys in May 2023. UHK management constantly review numbers of patients waiting on trolleys and action as appropriate.

As the last part of your query is directed to the minister in relation to his communications, I cannot comment in that regard.
