A scoping exercise is being carried out by HSE Disability Day Services Team, along with Co-Action & Local Link, with the expectation that a suitable solution can be put in place to resolve this issue.

The HSE will continue funding the existing arrangement for a maximum of three months while this review is conducted and alternative solutions found.
