Dear Deputy Shortall,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the following Parliamentary Question, which was submitted to this Department for response.

PQ 31288/23

To ask the Minister for Health the number of homecare hours provided by each voluntary NGO provider in the years 2021 and 2022; the costs of this provision per provider for the years 2021 and 2022; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

PQ 31289/23

To ask the Minister for Health the number of homecare hours provided by each private for-profit provider in the years 2021 and 2022; the costs of this provision per provider for the years 2021 and 2022; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

PQ 31290/23

To ask the Minister for Health the number of homecare hours provided directly by the State in the years 2021 and 2022; the costs of this provision for the years 2021 and 2022; and if he will make a statement on the matter

The Home Support Service is funded by Government to deliver a volume of service each year as approved in the HSE National Service Plan. It is a non-statutory service and access to the current service is based on assessment of the person's needs by the HSE and having regard to the available resources and the competing demands for the services.

Despite the significant level of service provision, the demand for Home Support, and its importance as an alternative service to long stay care, has grown considerably over the past number of years. Similarly, the type of Home Support that is now required to meet the needs of the population is a more person-centred personal care model. Home Support services are provided by both directly employed Healthcare Support Assistants (HCSAs) and by Approved Providers with formal tendered arrangements with the HSE, arrangements which encompass both commercial and voluntary providers.

In terms of the requested information, the breakdown of hours delivered and the costs involved between commercial and voluntary providers is not currently collated nationally. While this information may be available locally, it would take considerable resources to gather at national level. (PQ 31288/23 and PQ 31289/23).

However, we can provide the number of homecare hours provided through direct service provision (i.e. HSE delivered) and through indirect provision by external providers with service arrangements with the HSE. Appendix 1 sets out the National/CHO Home Support activity, for both Direct and Indirect service provision for 2021 and 2022. (PQ 31290/23)

Appendix 2 details the Home Support costs and hours delivered by direct and indirect Providers for the years 2021 and 2022, together with the associated costs. (PQ 31290/23).

All activity and costs set out in this response strictly relate to the Home Support Services funded through Services for Older People.
