The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which was submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I have reviewed the matter and the following is the current position.

Holy Angels received once off additional funding of €40,000 in February 2023.

Holy Angels will be receiving an inflation fund payment of €21,829 from South East Community Healthcare and a payment of €1,000 from CHO 6. Confirmation of the inflationary funding was sent to Holy Angels this week by the HSE and will be transferred into their account in the coming days.
