Patient Experience Time (PET) reporting aligns with HSE key performance indicators/targets. These targets are within time and age bands respectively. This information is published by HSE Business Intelligence Unit used to manage and drive performance improvement.

PET targets are monitored and reported in context of the following time bands:

6 Hours, 9 Hours, 24 Hours,

> 24 Hours (Please note that all patients waiting greater than 24 hours are included within this time band and could include patients waiting for longer time periods).
