Dear Deputy Cullinane

I refer to your recent PQ which has been forwarded to me for attention.

PQ 12415/23: To ask the Minister for Health the number of paediatric orthopaedic appointments, by appointment type, cancelled in January and February 2019-2022, inclusive, in tabular form; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Children's Health Ireland (CHI) Response:

I have followed up with Children's Health Ireland (CHI) and set out here-under the information that you require. Please see accompanying notes for each site below the tables.

Please note that data includes rescheduled appointments. Appointments are rescheduled for a number of reasons, some are hospital initiated such as when a Consultant is on leave or capacity is needed for urgent cases (eg post operation/infection) etc. Other appointments are rescheduled at the request of the parent or guardian for example if the child is unwell, away on holidays, has exams etc.

Rescheduled appointments are scheduled for the next available date based on the prioritisation of the appointment.

CHI endeavour to avoid cancelling and rescheduling appointments however there are circumstances outside of our control which require us to do so in some instances.

Data in above table is hospital initiated cancellations and reschedules.

Reasons for cancellations include Consultant not available, clinic is overbooked and rescheduling is required to make room for urgent or post-operative patients that need to be seen as a priority. Clinic numbers sometimes need to be reduced if there is not sufficient NCHD cover to support a full clinic.

In January and February 2019 the number of cancellations were higher due to the Nurses Strike at that time.
