Dear Deputy Troy

The Minister for Health has requested the HSE to respond directly to your Parliamentary Question;

**To ask the Minister for Health if he will review the funding that is provided to meals on wheels services and consider increasing their allocated funding, given they provide invaluable services to communities and are urgently in need of more support.**

There are currently 340 Meals on Wheels organisations in operation nationally delivering 250,000 (average) meals monthly to approximately 180,000 clients. These organisations are geographically located across 9 Community Health Organisations (CHO) and budgets are managed locally through each CHO.

Details of an additional €1.75m for 2023, specifically for Meals on Wheels, has been communicated to CHO Older Person Services for their onward distribution to local service providers, with a request to review and target where needed most. In addition, €3.5m was allocated for Day Care Services, many of which also provide Meals on Wheels services.

An overall evaluation of Meals on Wheels services is underway. This will include direct work with CHOs and consultation with the Irish Rural Network, Meals on Wheels Network Development Officer to understand gaps in availability and capacity of providers to increase or improve service delivery.
