Dear Deputy,

I refer to your recent Parliamentary Question which was sent to the HSE for response.

The Department of Health issued a circular regarding Payment of Clinical Placement Allowances to Undergraduate Supernumerary Nursing and Midwifery Students. This follows the Government decision in December and more recent funding approval from the Department of Public Expenditure and Reform. The allowances are intended as a contribution toward the cost of attending a supernumerary clinical placement and may include allowances for accommodation, travel, meals and costs for uniform laundry expenses.

These revised arrangements shall apply with effect from the start of the 2022/2023 academic year.

The HSE is currently engaging with the Department of Health concerning issues relating to the implementation of these measures.

I trust this clarifies and is of some assistance.
