I requested that the Business Manager in Disability Services examine the matter and the following outlines the position.

The data provided is by Local Health Office (LHO) area as this is the only detail available from The Assessment Officers' System Database (AOS). The Assessment Officers' System Database (AOS) that we use to facilitate the case management, planning and reporting of assessments and services to children with a disability eligible to apply for an assessment under the Disability Act, 2005 was particularly impacted by the Cyber-attack on HSE Systems and ICT Infrastructure. This has created many challenges for both Disability Services nationally and for system users locally.

The HSE is committed to the development of a new integrated Management Information System for Children's Disability Services, which will include a module on the Assessment of Need process under the Disability Act. This will facilitate the HSE to provide a wide range of reports on AON activity.
