Dear Deputy Tully,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question (PQ 20756/23) which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

Data in respect of Primary Medical Certificates is not routinely reported by the HSE. However, in response to queries in respect of Primary Medical Certificates in 2020, the data was collated from CHO areas in 2020 and subsequent years.
