To ask the Minister for Health whether the supplementary note accompanying the notification report on termination pregnancy in 2021 which indicated that 6,700 second consultation claims were made via the PCRS was limited to abortions provided by GPs/community providers or whether it included surgical abortions performed in hospital settings; and if he will make a statement on the matter. -Carol Nolan

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question (Reference 21933/23), which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The figures for second consultation is provided by a GPs/community providers and would not include surgical abortions performed in hospital settings. Please see attached the fees for services for Termination of pregnancy.
