Primary eye care in the community is delivered by general practitioners (GPs), optometrists and ophthalmologists. The HSE is committed to delivering efficient high quality services to all eligible service users. In 2022, there were 79,974 patients seen by HSE Ophthalmology services in Primary Care.
