To ask the Minister for Health the number of adverse incidents that were recorded in the health service in total in 2022 and for each of the previous four years; the number of adverse incidents that were recorded in each hospital group in the same timeframe; the number of adverse incidents that were recorded in each hospital; the number of adverse incidents that were recorded in each CAHMS region; if he will detail the nature of all of the aforementioned adverse incidents; the number of health servicerelated claims that have been lodged with the State Claims Agency for each of the past five years; and the amount in compensation that has been paid out by the State as a result of claims lodged against the health service.

Dear Deputy Toíbín

I refer to your parliamentary question above which has been referred to HSE Quality and Patient Safety Incident Management for response. I can provide incident data recorded on the National Incident Management System. Incident reporting generally is impacted by a number of factors and is not intended as a data collection point but primarily aids as a system that helps incident management and learning from such events. Please be advised that there are data limitations and anomalies that include potential duplication of incidents, variance in reporting and limited data validation, etc. The data below was extracted on the 26th June 2023 for HSE Hospitals and services - it does not include voluntary services (including voluntary hospitals). The majority of incidents had no harm or low level harm reported.

Number of adverse incidents recorded in the health service 2018 to 2022 and nature of adverse incidents.

The total number of adverse incidents recorded in the health service statutory organisations (Hospital and Community) 2018 to 2022 is 483,459.

Number of adverse incidents recorded in each Hospital Group 2018 to 2022 and nature of adverse incidents. Number of adverse incidents that were recorded in each hospital 2018 to 2022 and nature of adverse incidents.



See appendix A for a breakdown by hospital group (and CHO). The types of incidents can vary from incidents such as a fall, pressure ulcer, medication incident, etc.

Number of adverse incidents that were recorded in each CAMHS region 2018 to 2022 and nature of adverse incidents.

The National Incident Management System records incidents under the location where the incident occurred. See Appendix A for Community Services Data, this includes all statutory community services. It is all encompassing of community services regions and does not limit the incident data to CAMHS solely.

The number of health service-related claims that have been lodged with the States Claims Agency for each of the past five years.

The HSE does not have access to this data – please refer this question to the State Claims Agency.

The amount in compensation that has been paid out by the State as a result of claims lodged against the health service.

The HSE does not have access to this data – please refer this question to the State Claims Agency.
