The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which was submitted to the Minister for Children; Equality; Disability; Integration and Youth for response.

I have reviewed the matter and the following is the current position.

Regretfully, SECH Mental Health services does not provide a service for Adult ADHD/ADD. The HSE has a national pilot for ADHD in adults which is currently restricted to 3 CHOs across the country but unfortunately, SECH are not one of the chosen sites.
