PQ/43313/23 To ask the Minister for Health if compulsory overtime is taken into consideration when calculating pensions within the ambulance service; and if he will make a statement on the matter

The Health Service Executive (HSE) National Ambulance Service (NAS) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above parliamentary question which you submitted to the Minister for response.

Different rules apply to different circumstances including individual circumstances and whether or not overtime working is including in reckonable earnings.
