To ask the Minister for Health how many people have died in Ireland from stroke per year from 2014 to 2021 inclusive, in tabular form; and if he will make a statement on the matter

Dear Deputy Ring,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in relation to the above parliamentary question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have consulted with the National Clinical Programme (NCP) for Stroke on your question and have been informed that the following outlines the position.

A recently published report entitled *Irish National Audit of Stroke (INAS) National Report: A critical review of national stroke data for Ireland from 2013 to 2021*¹ reported the following mortality rate from 2014 to 2021 outlined in Table 1 below.

Data has been reported based on type of stroke – ischaemic or haemorrhagic. The percentage (%) figure is recorded as: <u>the mortality rate as a % of the total number of stroke admissions</u>. While the mortality rate for haemorrhagic stroke has remained unchanged, the mortality rate for ischaemic Stroke has reduced from 10% in 2014 to 7.2% in 2021, a 29% reduction. The reduction in mortality for ischaemic stroke is largely due to better provision of acute stroke unit care and advancements in the hyperacute management of ischaemic stroke i.e. thrombolysis and thrombectomy. Haemorrhagic stroke remains a key target of the National Clinical Programme (NCP) for Stroke to support care pathway development, implementation of new treatments and clinical trials.
