The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position for Community Healthcare Cavan Donegal Leitrim Monaghan Sligo.

The programme for Domestic, Sexual & Gender Based Violence (DSGBV) lies with Tusla who provide national co-ordination, funding and support to a specialist service to support women, men and children who are victims and survivors of domestic, sexual or gender based violence.

It is suggested that this PQ be redirected to Tusla.

Kindly note this response was held due Fórsa Industrial Action which has now been lifted.
