Dear Deputy Healy-Rae,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) - South (Cork & Kerry) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the following Parliamentary Question, which was submitted to this office for response.

PQ Question:

To ask the Minister for Health further to Parliamentary Question No. 1803 of 11 September 2023, the ongoing costs involved in this job in UHK (details supplied); and if he will make a statement on the matter. -Michael Healy-Rae

Details Supplied: Minister, can you have the HSE answer the following questions; With regard to the flooding event that took place in UHK, I have the following questions; 1. How many diagnostics machines were damaged by the flooding.2? Can a detail cost be given for the replacement/repair of each machine.3? How many of these machine are currently operational.4. Provide a list of the machines/equipment that is currently not operational. 5. What impact has this had on the delivery of services in the hospital? 6. Has an insurance claim been submitted or indeed claimed, if so how much?

The full list of equipment damaged, including diagnostic equipment, is listed below. Please note, this is the current cost and may be subject to change when funding is received and the order is placed.

The loss of this equipment has impacted on the volume and throughput of patients in the Cardiology Services. University Hospital Kerry (UHK) has sought to minimise this impact by funding some priority equipment, while we await the final insurance assessment, and has also borrowed some equipment from other hospitals and from suppliers.

The insurance claim was submitted immediately after the flood. This claim was for both building and equipment damaged. Please see breakdown in attached spreadsheet. Unfortunately the insurance company currently has not approved the claim for the replacement Cardiology equipment. UHK continues to engage with the insurance company to resolve this matter as quickly as possible, and UHK has escalated this delay through the appropriate channels in the HSE.
