Dear Deputy Murphy,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in regard to your parliamentary question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for a response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The Health Service Executive can confirm in Community Healthcare Organisation 7 (CHO7), aids and appliances are funded from a central cost centre managed by the Primary Care Service. There is no facility to split this expenditure by care group/disability therefore we cannot provide the information requested above. However, the total amount spent on aids and appliances for the years 2021, 2020 and to date in 2023 in CHO7 is detailed below:
