- As a reference point, data is provided for January of each year as the number of radiographers required in CHI at Connolly will vary with outpatient clinic activity.
- The number of radiographers allocated to CHI at Connolly is aligned with current opening hours and activity and will be increased as required to align with new opening hours and/or activity changes in the future.
