

**Details Supplied:** Minister, with regard to University Hospital Kerry, there was a flooding incident there where water entered the building during heavy rain fall. What exactly is the total cost of repair and replacement of equipment etc for this flood damage

The estimated cost of damage, including equipment replacement, is €950,000 inclusive of VAT. Works are in progress, in relation to this, and once completed we will have final costs from vendors.
