The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

To date 14 PCCs have been delivered using a public private partnership (PPP) model which was approved by the HSE Directorate in March 2016, as part of a wider government PPP initiative.

Payments for the 14 Primary Care Centres (PCCs) delivered through Public Private Partnership (PPP) commenced in 2017 when the first PCCs were handed over.

Each year costs are amended to reflect changes in the Consumer Price Index (CPI).
