Dear Deputy Conway Walsh,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

Please find enclosed details on all primary care centres (PCCs) currently in development as requested.

Appendix 1 lists the location and delivery mechanism of 14 PCCs currently in construction.

Appendix 2 contains the information of 71 PCCs which are presently in development including the current proposed delivery mechanism for each centre.

To date 14 PCCs have been delivered using a public private partnership (PPP) model which was approved by the HSE Directorate in March 2016, as part of a wider government PPP initiative. There are no plans at present to deliver additional PCCs via the PPP model.
