PQ 39329/23: To ask the Minister for Health the numbers of GMS registered GPs on a county basis for the years 2015-2023; and if he will make a statement on the matter. -Jennifer Whitmore

Dear Deputy Whitmore,

I refer to the above PQ received in our office for response. Please find attached number of General Practitioners (GMS GPs) nationally for your attention.

The Department of Health, the Health Service Executive (HSE) and the Irish Medical Organisation (IMO) concluded an Agreement in July, 2023, which makes provision for a range of measures, including the extension of means tested eligibility to Doctor Visit only cards to individuals and families and full eligibility to all children aged between 6 and 7 years inclusive.

The 2023 GP Agreement also provides for a series of financial supports to GPs in order to maintain and increase capacity in general practices. Financial supports include increased Capitation Fee Rates, enhanced subsidies and a new form of practice grant to allow GPs to recruit additional staff as well to take account of increased demand for services. The Agreement also includes pilot initiates to address challenges in filling long term GMS GP vacancies in rural and urban deprived areas. In addition, a pilot initiative will be progressed aimed at supporting GPs who are in receipt of Rural Practice Support to source locum GP cover for approved leave periods. To date 2,451 (96%) eligible GPs have signed up to the 2023 GP Agreement.

The 2023 GP Agreement is an interim Agreement pending the completion of the recommendations of the GP Strategic Review, which has recently commenced. The Strategic Review will identify the challenges facing General Practice in delivering a sustainable service into the future and set out the actions necessary to address those challenges. It will examine a wide range of issues, including, in particular, GP Capacity, GP Training and the financial support necessary to ensure a sustainable service.

I trust this is of assistance.
