PQ Question: To ask the Minister for Health the number of people in each local health office area waiting for a child and adolescent mental health services appointment as of 1 September 2023 or the latest date available: the number waiting 0 to 12, 12 to 26, 26 to 52 weeks and the number waiting more than 52 weeks. –Michael Moynihan.

Dear Deputy Moynihan,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

CAMHS provide specialist mental health services to those aged up to 18 years, who have reached the threshold for a diagnosis of moderate to severe mental health disorder that require the input of multi-disciplinary mental health teams. The table below provides the latest available information on the number of children and young people waiting to be seen by CAMHS as at end of **July 2023**. Please be advised that this data is preliminary and subject to change and amendment pending ongoing review and validation.
