Dear Deputy Burke,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

Where a patient has been hospitalized due to Covid-19 infection, the treating consultant will arrange for a follow up appointment if deemed medically necessary and inform the patient's GP of same upon discharge from hospital

Where a follow up appointment is not deemed necessary upon discharge but subsequently becomes necessary, GP's can refer the patient for a follow up appointment.
