The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

Balbriggan Primary Care Centre delivers a variety of integrated care services to meet the health needs of the local population. The current services on offer in Balbriggan Primary Care Centre are:

- Addiction Outreach clinic (Adult)
- Adult Mental Health Services
- Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services (CAMHS)
- Mental Health Day Hospital
- Counselling in Primary Care (CIPC)
- Community Medical Doctor
- Dental (Adult and Paediatric special care)
- Dietetics
- Nursing (Adult and Paediatric)
- Occupational Therapy (Adult and Paediatric)
- Physiotherapy (Adult and Paediatric)
- Primary Care Social work (adult)
- Psychology (Child)
- Rotunda Community clinics
- Smoking cessation clinics
- Speech and Language Therapy (Adult and Paediatric)
- Substance Abuse Service Specific to Youth (SASSY) 0-18yrs
- Children's Disability Network Team
- Limited services for Chronic Disease (Dublin North/Beaumont hub)
- Advice clinics for Psychology, Occupational Therapy and Speech and Language Therapy (see attached flyers detailing how to access these clinics)

In addition to the above HSE services, the following non-HSE services are also available from the primary care centre:

- Two private GP Practices
- Pharmacy
- Private Physiotherapy clinic
- St Michael's House Adult Day Services

An Infant Feeding Lactation Consultant Clinic is under development.
