Dear Deputy Wynne,


The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I have been in contact with the relevant staff and I have been informed that coronary care services for the Mid-West region are provided at University Hospital Limerick. There are no plans to provide a coronary care unit in Ennis Hospital.

A number of cardiology services are available in Ennis Hospital and in the Chronic Disease Hub for patients. These include an outpatient service, a cardiac rehabilitation service and a cardiac diagnostic services.
