In addition to the expenditure noted above, a total of €410,000 was expended at St Joseph's Hospital on emergency programme of works in response to the Covid 19 pandemic in 2020.

Fire safety works are being planned for St Joseph's Hospital Stranorlar in 2024, with an estimated project cost of €150,000.
