The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for response. I apologies for the delay in responding to you and any inconvenience caused.

The HSE's National Service Plan 2024 was published recently and sets out the quantum and type of services to be delivered in 2024. The Plan outlines measures relating to GP and consultant recruitment, improvements to service user and staff experience in Emergency Departments (Urgent & Emergency Care) including avoidance measures. In addition, the risks to the delivery of the Plan and actions to mitigate these risks.
