The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question (Reference 28039/24), which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

Please see below results for the number of people on Dexcom G7 and the number of people who previously received Dexcom G6 and are now on Dexcom G7 for 2023.

Please note:

- The information provided is based on claims data received by the Primary Care Reimbursement Service (PCRS) from Community Pharmacists and includes items reimbursed by PCRS only.

- The data does not capture items dispensed outside of community drug schemes where the prescription is paid for privately, nor does it include claims which are under the DPS monthly threshold amount.
- PCRS does not capture data in relation to diagnoses or indications for the medicines reimbursed.
